It's disappointing that we're...as we sit here in June of 2010, that's we've still had three trials in the history of Guantanamo. As we've mentioned, David Hicks got a nine-month sentence, you know, essentially a misdemeanor punishment. Salim Hamdan effectively got a five and a half month sentence. You've got, what, 180 people that are locked up at Guantanamo, that have never faced trial; you've got two people that have been convicted as war criminals that are free men. I mean, so kind of, the running joke was, in order to win at Gitmo, you have to lose. You know, you have to go to court and lose and be convicted as a war criminal, and you might get to go home. Or you can never face trial and be locked up indefinitely.
