### **Bev Hicks—Not the Same**

*Interviewer: And what was your sense of David when you first met him?*

..... A lost, a lost soul. Just, um, I don't know how to describe that. It wasn't good. A lost soul, frightened. And very anxious.

They play with their heads, play with their minds. And I'm sure that's what's happened to him. He's not sure of anything anymore. He's not sure on making decisions. I don't know much about Guantanamo and what goes on in there, but I know that something happened to him. With his mind.

And David doesn't talk about it. And don't ask me why, we don't ask questions. Cause we don't, I don't want to, um, him, going back and thinking about what may have happened to him there. You sort of keep away from that area. You sort of think to yourself, "if he wants to tell you, he'll tell you." It's like the men who go to war, isn't it? They don't talk about what they did, so I guess it's the same principle. But he's not the same lad. They definitely did something to his mind in there.
